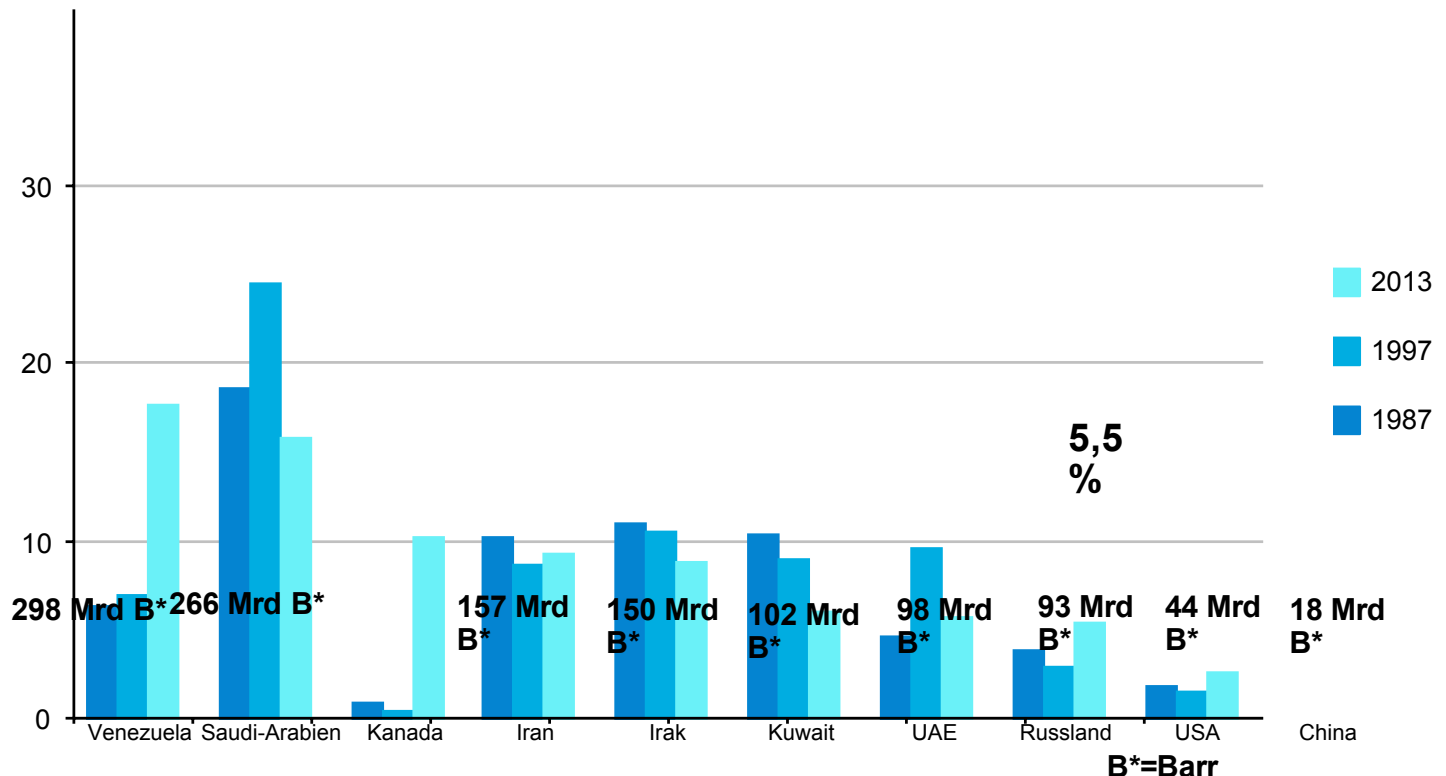

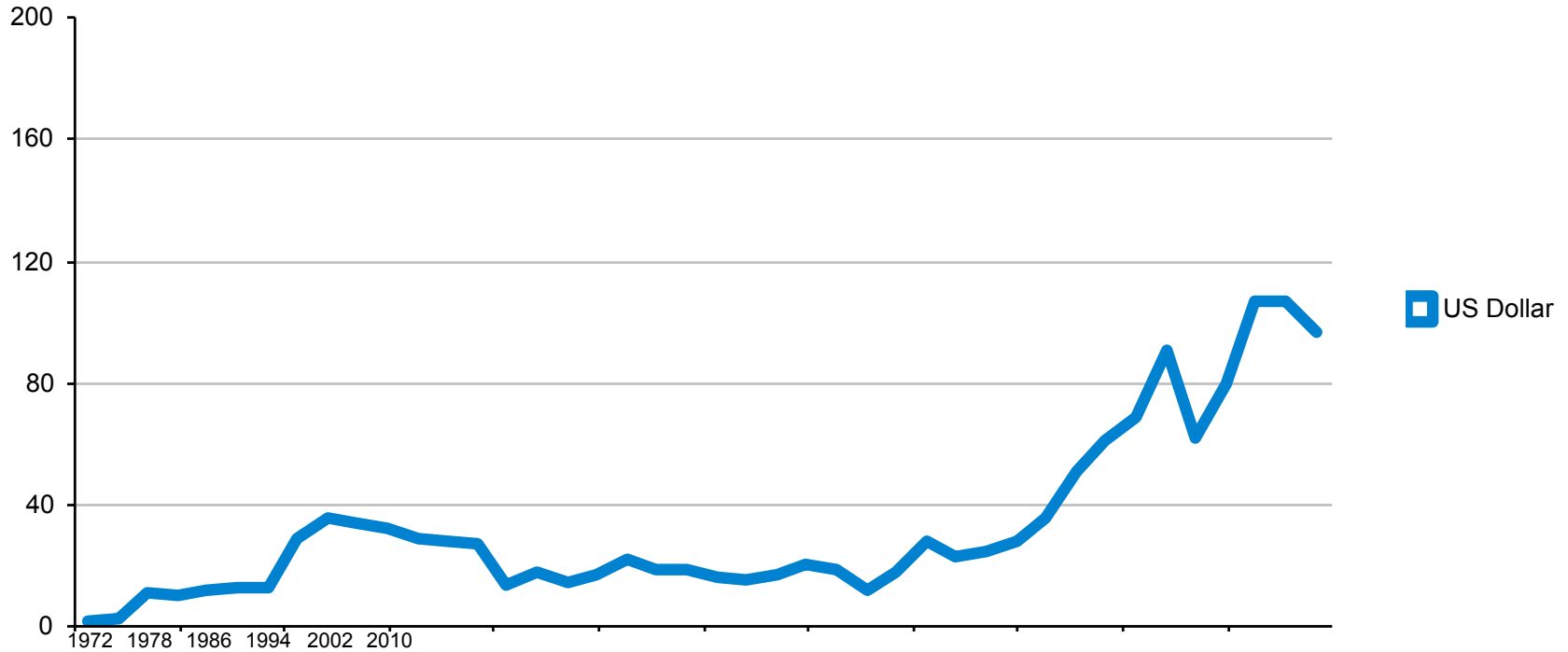

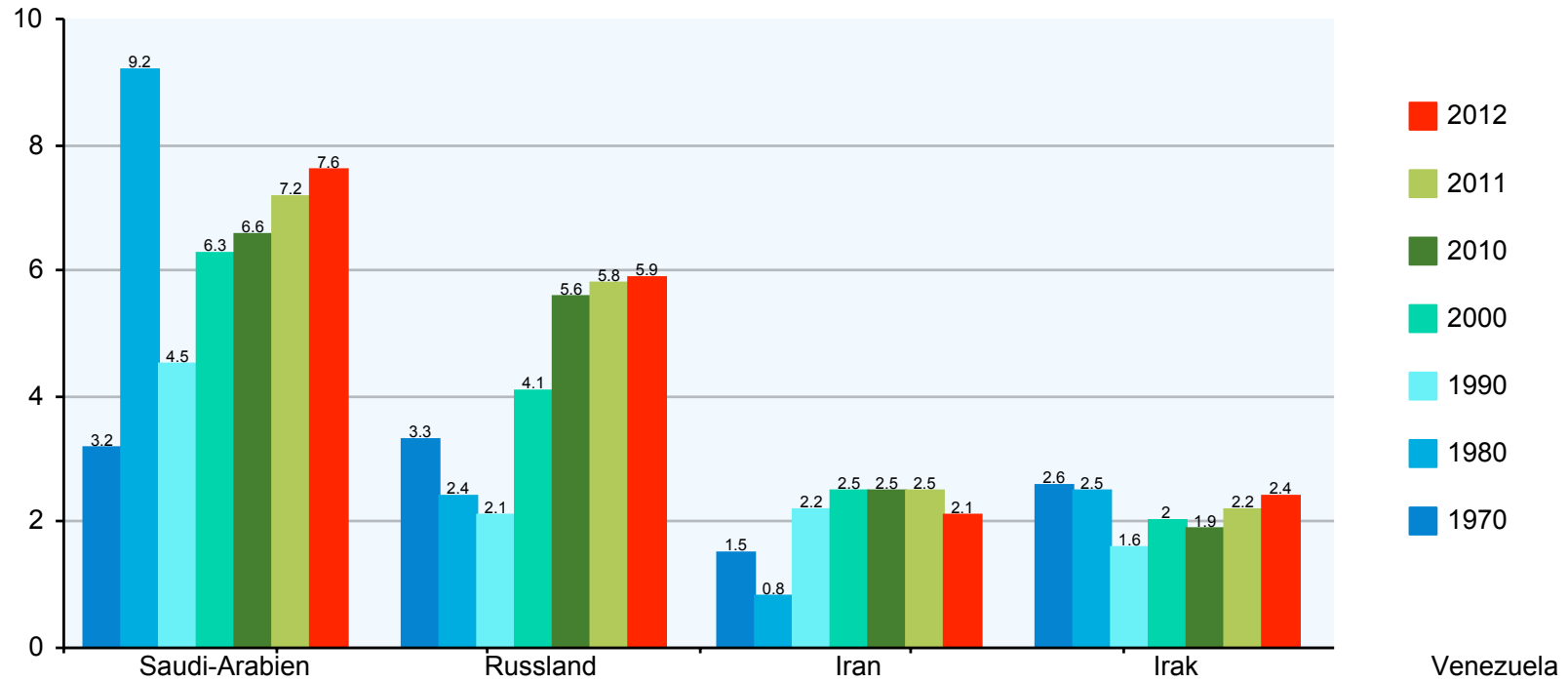

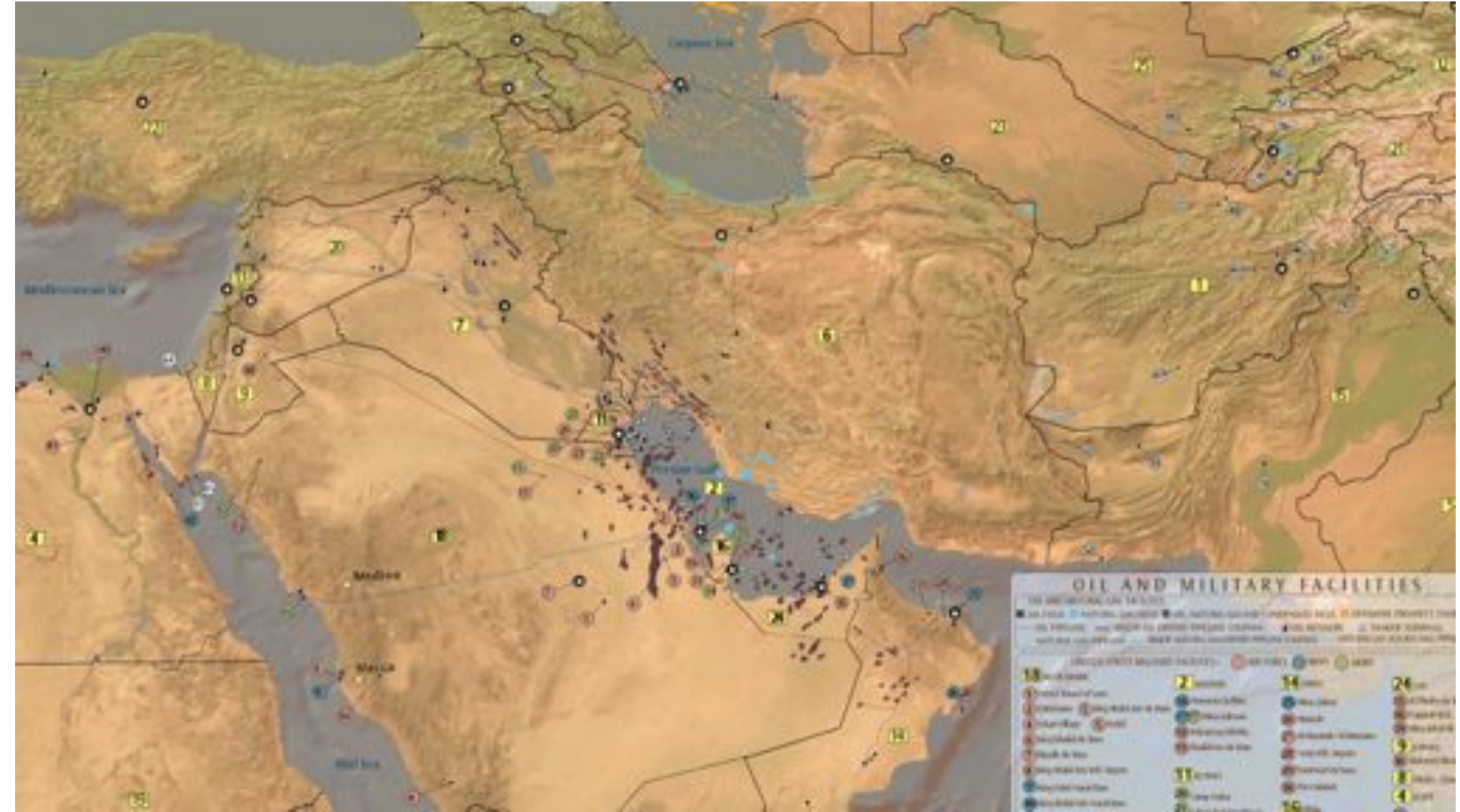


Weltölexport (Mio. Barrel täglich)

Anstieg auf 40,5 Mio. Barrel (2012)*

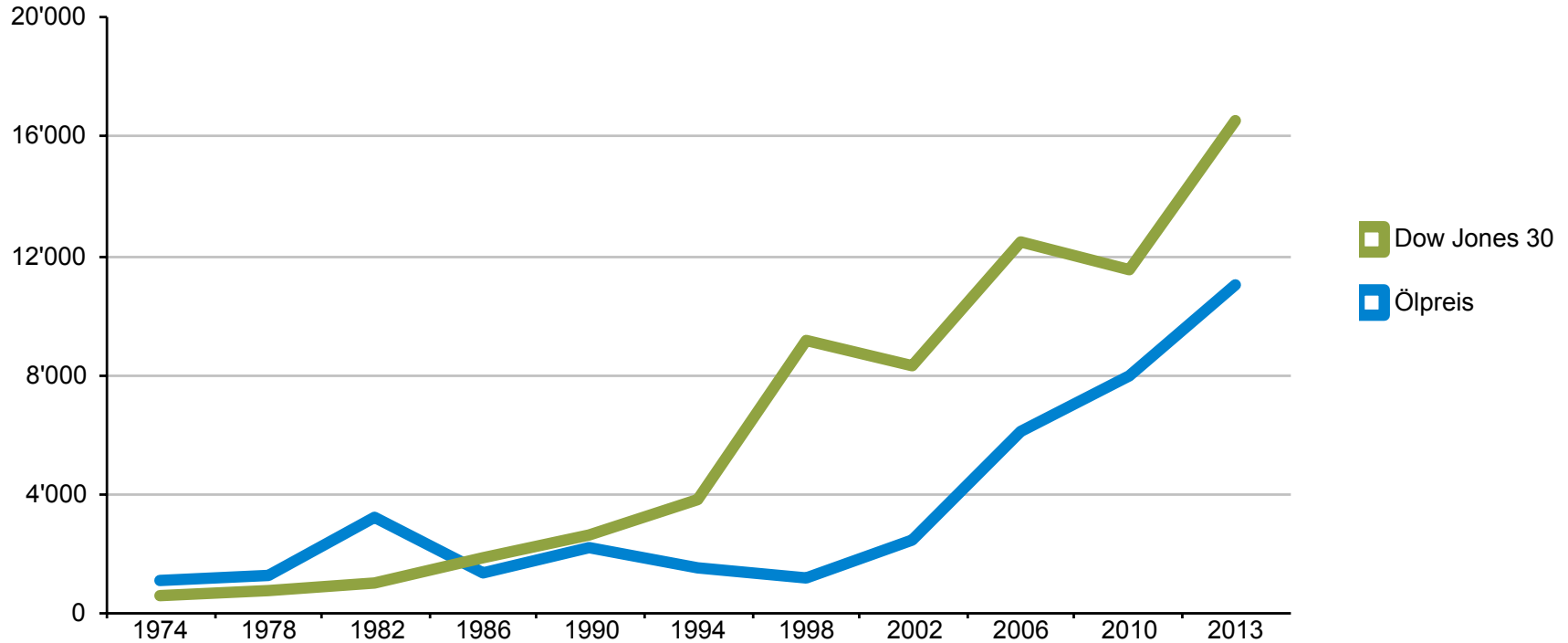

Entwicklung Ölpreise (\$-Cent) und Dow Jones 30 (1972 – 2013)

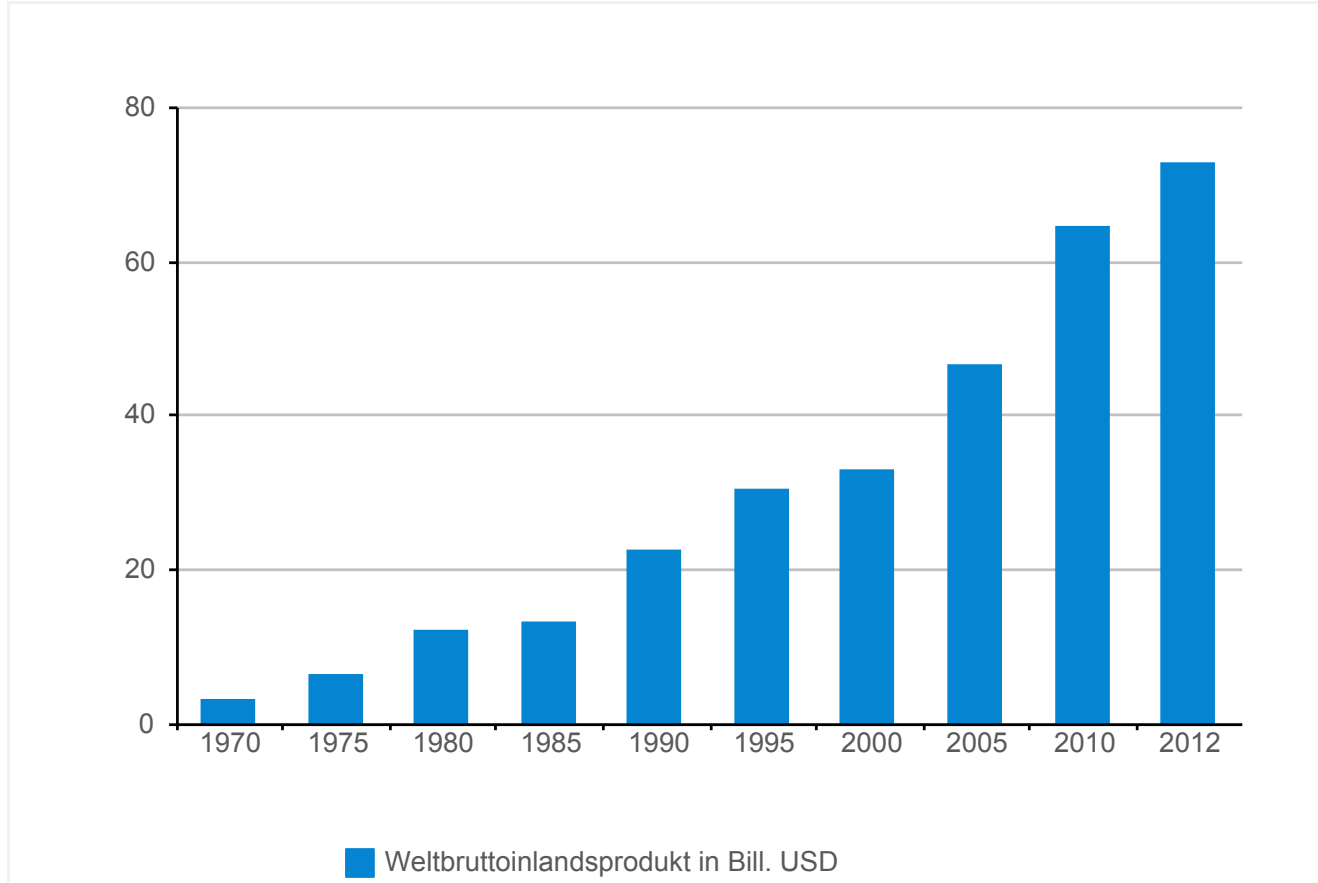

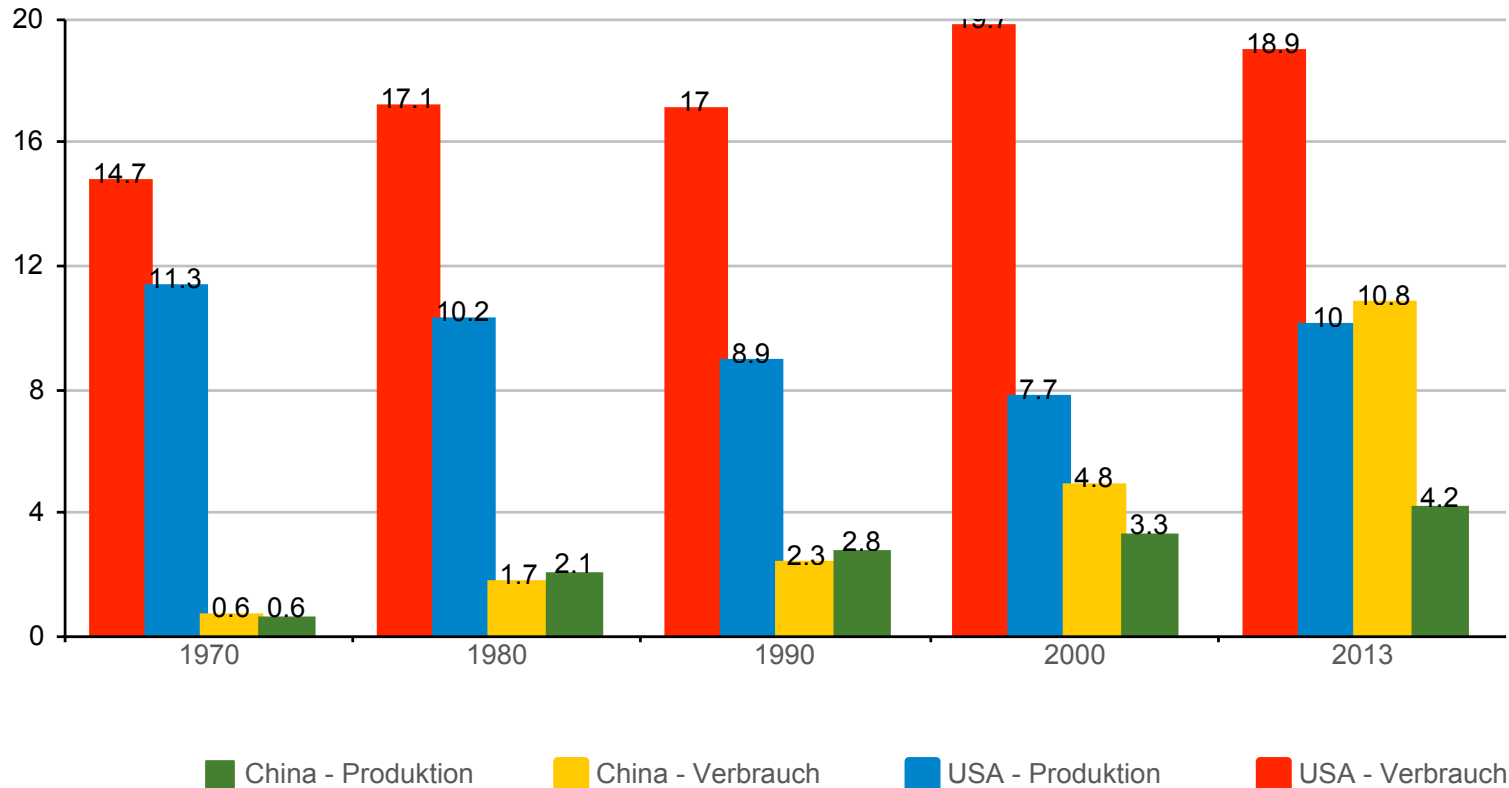


Weltbruttoinlandsprodukt (in Bill.USD) und Ölpreisentwicklung (in USD)

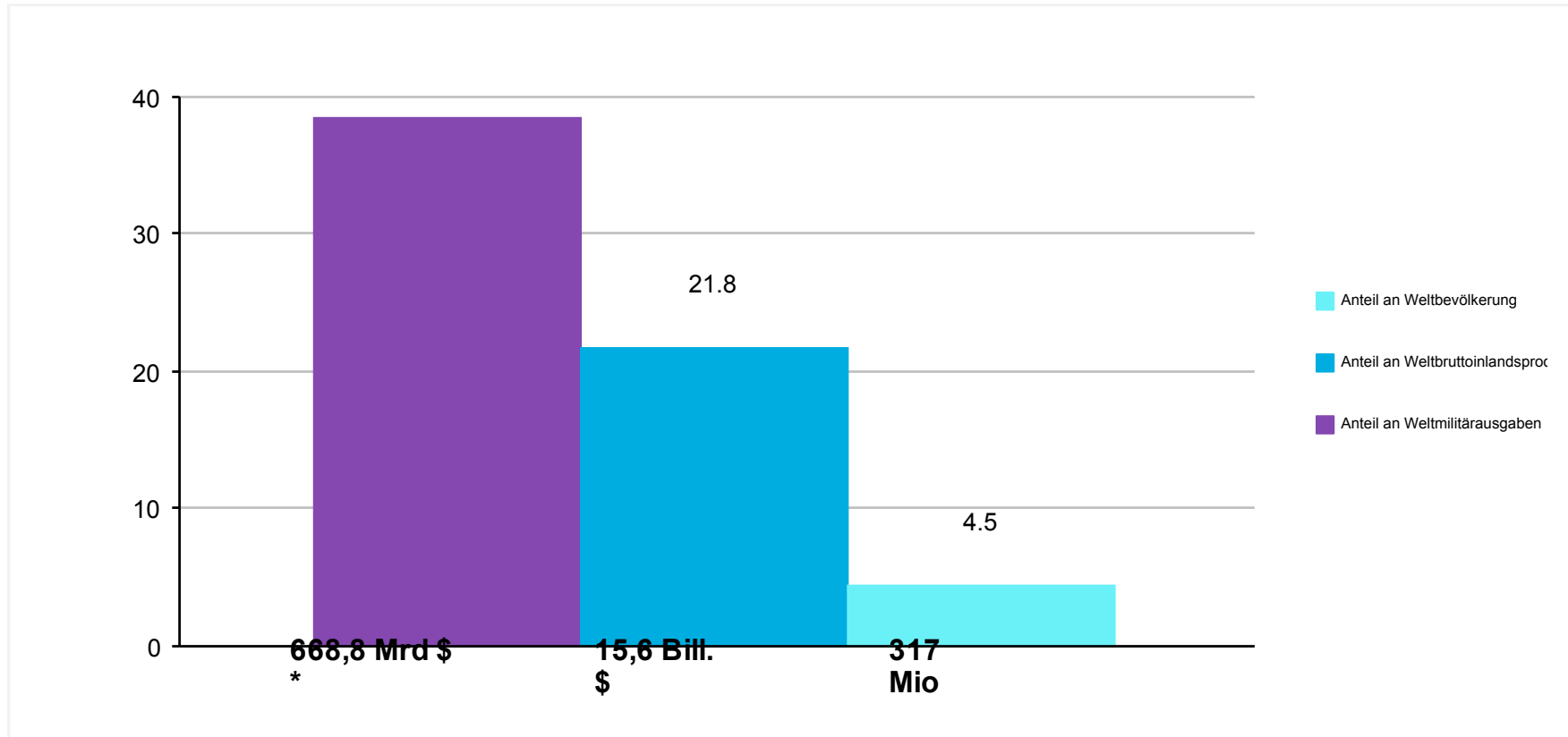

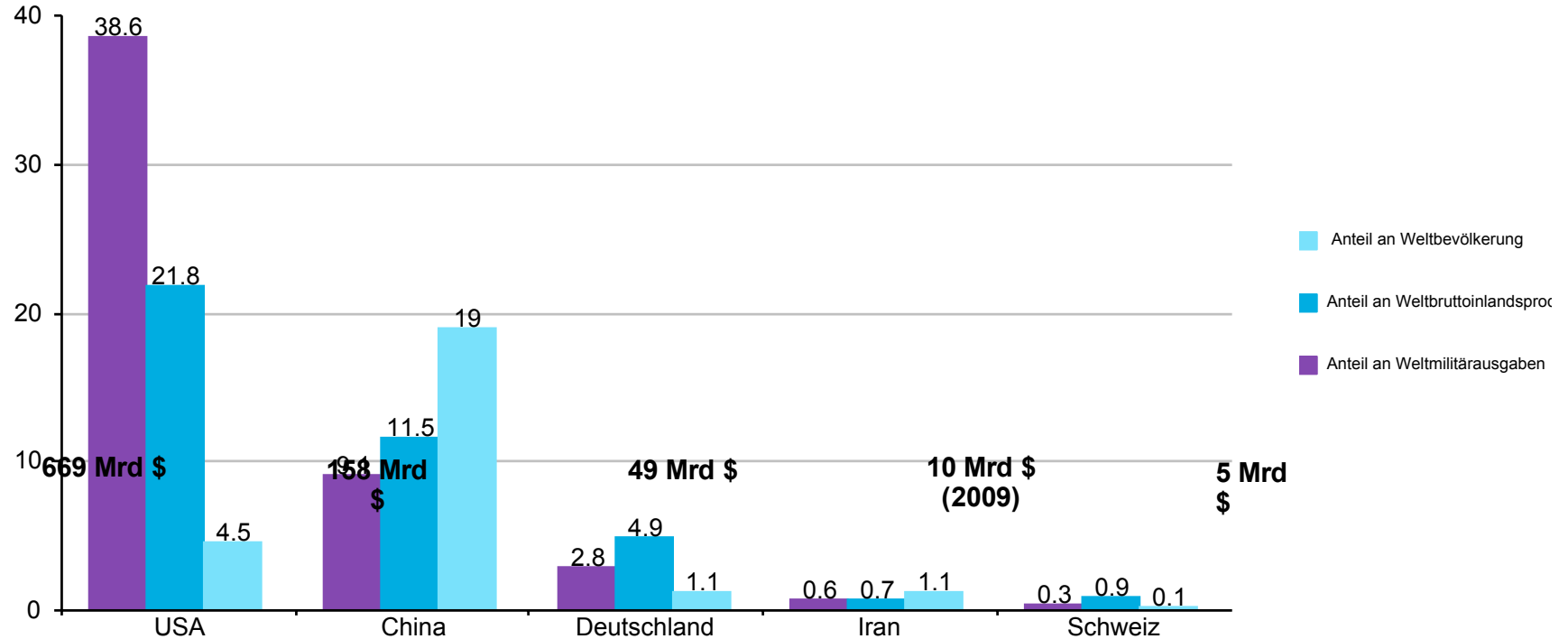


Militärausgaben, Produktion, Bevölkerung USA 2012

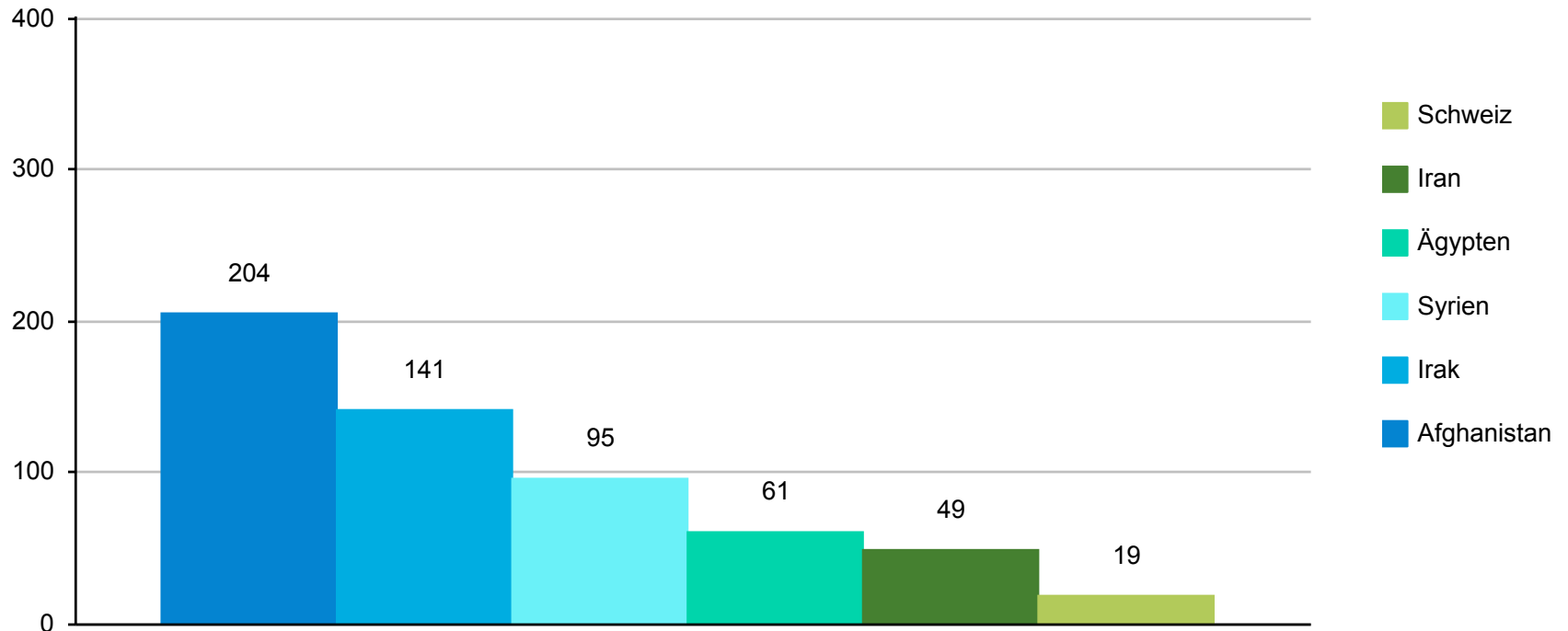

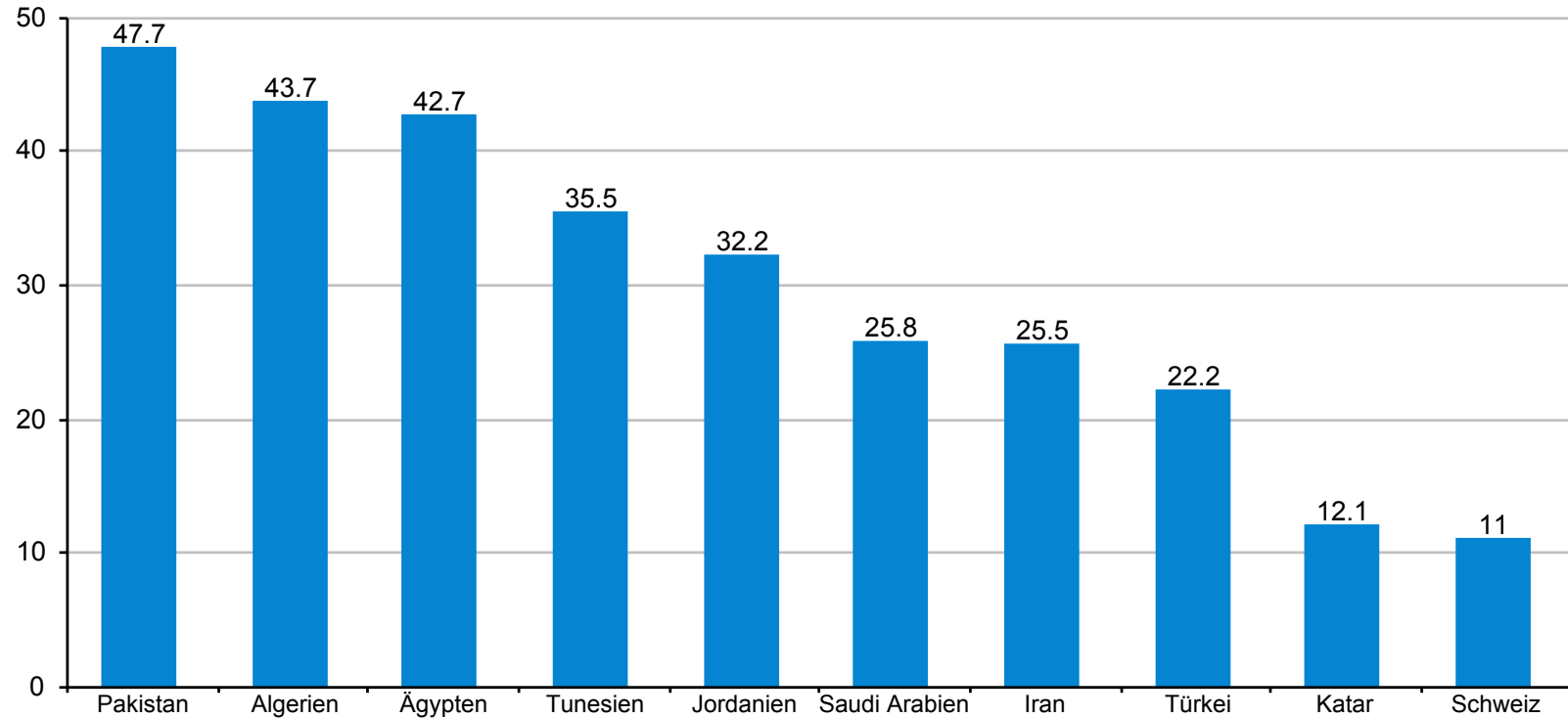
Bevölkerungsentwicklung von 1990 bis 2020*
